What we do

What does 12Build do?

12Build is a SaaS solution for the construction industry. This solution enables companies in the construction industry to work faster and more efficiently. Think about exchanging offers digitally, comparing different offers and managing them. All communication and documentation takes place within the platform.

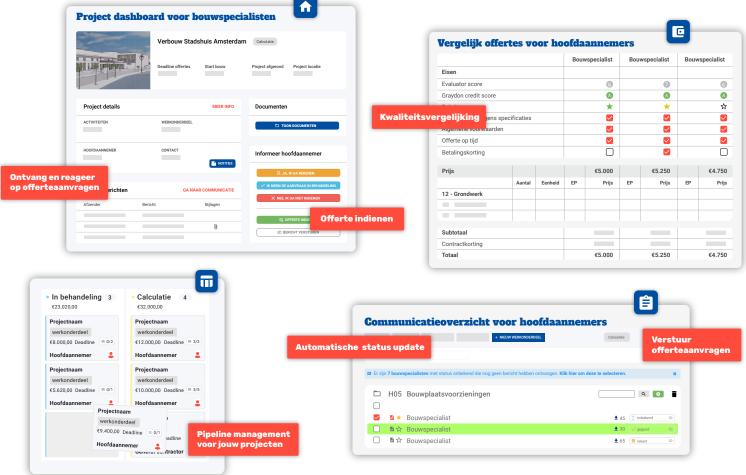
Our process starts with clients wanting to start construction projects. To find construction companies that can carry out these projects, a selection process is started: tendering. Construction companies participate in tenders by submitting bids to clients to carry out the project. In turn, these construction companies (general contractors) often subcontract a lot of work to construction specialists, also known as subcontractors. Think of plasterers or concrete braiders. There are also suppliers who supply the necessary materials.

A tender from a client triggers a long and complex quotation process among all parties involved. General contractors want to submit a bid for the tender, but first need to obtain quotes from subcontractors and suppliers. This entire process can take place within 12Build's SaaS solution.

Construction companies create construction projects in 12Build, creating and managing tenders (Tender management). Furthermore, the exchange of offers and their management takes place (Bid management), and 12Build offers the possibility to keep track of information about suppliers and subcontractors (Supplier management). Together, all these elements form a marketplace in which buyers and suppliers can cooperate and exchange offers during the procurement process.

Our solutions

12Build's SaaS solution transform the construction industry, from tender management to supplier management to Europe's largest marketplace. Our solutions improve efficiency and enjoyment in construction projects. Wondering how they work? We'll explain that to you briefly. This may seem overwhelming, but don't worry - during your onboarding you'll get a detailed explanation.



Tender Management

Tender management is **the process of organizing and managing bids for construction projects.** A successful construction project starts with finding the right partners and proper procurement. 12Build's tender management solution makes it easy to gather all project requirements and invite suppliers and subcontractors to collaborate on the project. This can be done by publishing specific parts of the project on 12Build or by sending invitations in person. For a good proposal, it is essential to know what materials and services are needed, what quality is required, and what the cost will be.

Supplier Management

Supplier management is the process of effectively managing relationships with suppliers and subcontractors. This forms the basis for good sourcing. Once good and reliable subcontractors or partners are identified through sourcing, relationships can be developed with them. Within 12Build, this includes negotiating prices, tracking quality through certifications, evaluating performance and ensuring that each other's needs are continually met.

Bid Management

Bid management is **the process of managing requests and bids for construction projects.** This includes managing these, including viewing statuses and current projects. When responding to a bid request for a construction project, it is important to be able to quickly show value added and accurately estimate costs. By knowing the cost of materials and labor well and processing them quickly, a competitive quote can be prepared.

Campaign Builder

12Build's Campaign Builder helps subcontractors and suppliers increase their visibility within the 12Build Marketplace. This tool is designed for subcontractors to increase their discoverability by potential customers, which is essential to the success and growth of their business.

This feature allows users to create targeted marketing campaigns that enhance their presence within 12Build. This is done by optimizing their business profiles so that they stand out better in the platform's search results.

Marketplace

At the heart of our platform lies our sweet spot, which is what makes 12Build unique. This is where our three main solutions converge into a singular marketplace. It facilitates a complete ecosystem for sourcing, buying and selling, driven by supply and demand.

Why we don't think in boxes

We believe that **happy colleagues ensure happy customers.** To be happy in your work, you have to have fun and be able to be the best version of yourself. 12Builders have fresh eyes, think differently, have an opinion and are not afraid of a little change. Personal development

360-degree feedback

In a flat organization like 12Build's, it is very important that colleagues can provide feedback to each other. After all, it is up to us to help and support each other. Feedback is an important tool for this. We therefore use 360-degree feedback with Leapsome. You are in control of your own personal development.

You can choose who you ask for feedback and what goals you want to set. And together with your team lead, you decide which tools you can use to achieve your goals. Our corporate culture makes it easy to give honest feedback. This is because we are open and dare to tell each other the truth.

DISC-scan

Every new colleague undergoes a DISC scan to gain deeper insights into their personality. This helps you discover your preferred communication style, how you like to collaborate, and what motivates you. Along with the scan, you'll have an **in-depth session with an external coach** who will help you understand the results and provide tools for your personal development.





12Build Growth hub

Making mistakes is mandatory.

After all, it means that you are pushing boundaries. Continuous change is the foundation of our beautiful organization. It is therefore logical that we find personal development important. While working here, you not only contribute to the organization, but also to yourself. In other words, personal growth. In fact: this is expected of you! Sometimes you discover that you lack knowledge

or would like to deepen something. We encourage you to continue to learn from each other. We have so much knowledge and experience in-house that with some practical tips or a little coaching from colleagues, you can make quick steps. But, if necessary, you will of course also be given the space to follow training, courses and workshops. We heartily encourage you to take advantage of this to expand your competencies

and develop in a direction that makes you happy. Have you seen a great study, course, training or something else to help you in your development? Then report it, and we will discuss it together. And how do you know where you can develop? Through the results of your 360-degree feedback via Leapsome you can see at a glance where your development opportunities lie.

Job title and salary (9-Grid)

At 12Build, we don't like to lay out everything in detail. When it comes to your job and your tasks, we focus more on your responsibilities. We give you a framework within which you have the freedom for your own initiatives and insights.

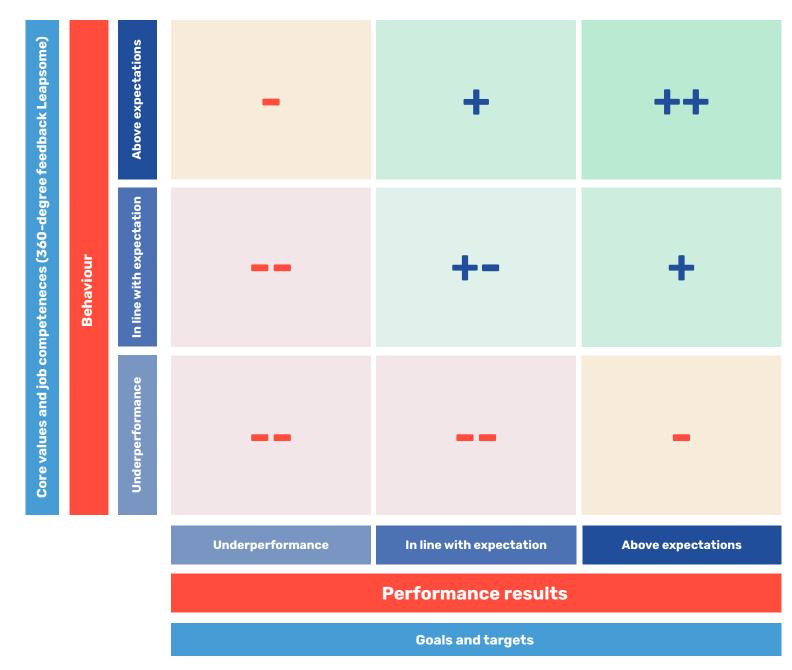
These frameworks are largely fixed per function and per function level. So you know what is expected of you. We evaluate these job profiles every year so that they remain up-to-date. The job profiles also form the basis of the 360-degree feedback described above.

You can also immediately see what pay is appropriate for positions/levels. This is because this is listed in our salary house. An annual benchmark ensures that our salaries always remain competitive with the market.

Annual salary changes occur each January. These salary changes are determined using the 9-Grid method. A clear method that considers both results and behavior in determining your salary increase. And the easiest part is that you can see in advance which raise fits which score. Scores are taken from several sources, but the most important are Leapsome (360-degree feedback) and results on targets.

The job and salary house are internally available for all to see.

Working at 12Build

The application process

You are open to a new job, we are looking for a top performer. To see if we are a "match made in heaven," we have an extensive application process. We use scorecards for this purpose. These scorecards list the tasks, competencies and required knowledge and experience on which we will interview you. In addition, of course, we will do our best to sell ourselves. Because what we all write in this book sometimes seems too good to be true. We are going to show you and experience that this is really how things are done here.

The application consists of three interviews. After someone from HR meets by phone and checks the key factors, the next appointment is scheduled.



An initital meeting with HR and your manager

With the goal to get acquainted and see if there is a competency match.



The 2nd interview is with 2 team members

In this conversation, we will go deeper into what the job actually entails and check for the necessary skills and knowledge level. Answer any questions that arose after the first interview.



The most important conversation: The culture fit

In an introductory meeting with Erik, we will look at your cultural fit and motivations and want to further excite you to join us.

Between the second and third interviews, you will also receive a contract proposal from us, clarifying your potential earnings. In some instances, we may also request a presentation or case study from you.

A flying start

Have you made your choice and will you be joining 12Build? Cool, we will provide you with a warm welcome. Your onboarding actually started during the job interview. Together we looked at how you fit within our organization. We work with a buddy system, which means that someone within your team will be paired with you and help you through the whole onboarding process. That onboarding takes several weeks so you'll be up and running in no time. On your first day at work, you will be welcomed to the office by the team lead and your buddy. We always start with the practical stuff. Setting up and adjusting your workspace, accessing all systems and tools,

logging into your Google account, and so on. Then you'll visit the different teams. All new people! Don't panic, today you will mainly get to know your team and other colleagues who are present. Because there is a lot to deal with on your first day, we start by going over the schedule, explaining exactly what your week will look like and what you can expect from us. Furthermore, we make sure you quickly breathe the 12Build DNA. We do this by scheduling strategy sessions and culture sessions. After a few weeks you can call yourself a real 12Builder. Whether it's about core values, strategy or how the coffee machine works, you'll know everything.

The onboarding box

On the first day of work, you will find an onboarding box. In it you will find a bingo list that you get to go through completely over the next few weeks. Have you checked it off completely? Then you will receive something fun! Of course, we won't tell you what's in the onboarding box just yet. But it will get you off to a flying start!

Your worlplace

You probably spend more time at your desk here in the office than you do sitting on the couch at home, so we make sure your workstation is properly adjusted. In addition, of course, you'll get everything you need to do your job like a pro. We will provide you with a brand new laptop, which you can also choose yourself. All options and possibilities are described in our internal hardware policy.

We have set up all workstations plug-and-play. This way, colleagues can easily sit in all places and you don't have to crawl under your desk every working day to unplug cords. Of course, we (still) have two offices, one in Nijverdal and the other in Zwolle. How nice to take a look at the other office as well! We therefore recommend everyone to switch offices once in a while.

Working from home

Working from home is only natural for us. And easy, with your own company laptop. The most important thing is that you make good arrangements with your team members, so that you can come together at the office at important moments. In general, the rule is: if you work full-time and live a reasonable distance from the office, you will be at the office at least 2 days a week. Do you live further away? Then we will make appropriate arrangements with you. In some cases we can even arrange hotel accommodation for our colleagues. And of course we will help you set up your home office! Do you need anything, such as an extra keyboard or monitor? Then you can ask Support.

There are several opportunities for advancement, both within your position and company-wide. It's great that all of this is possible.



An office garden, not an office jungle!

Both in Nijverdal and Zwolle we work in an inspiring office garden. There is a lot of telephoning and consultation in the open-plan office. In addition, some colleagues like to show how good they are with a Nerf gun, which others try to surpass with a soccer. This makes the offices cozy, but also sometimes restless. We humans are programmed to respond when called; a phone ringing, the mailbox filling up, pop-ups from Slack, a system

Ultimately, it took over three years to actually complete my transition, which was mostly due to the right timing from both sides.



What attracts me to 12Build is the ambition to grow to a Champions League level as a company, while guarding the culture and values of 12Build. The culture and values have brought us to where we are today and in a fast growing company it is easy to let go of this, but that very guarding makes the difference compared to other companies. Practicalities



Working hours

We have flexible working hours. This means you are free to plan your working hours as you prefer, as long as you coordinate this well with your team members and you can get the most out of your working hours. When you're in the office, we use our time between noon and 1 p.m. to have a nice sandwich or play a game of FIFA or table tennis.

We do not work overtime unless it is really necessary. If you structurally work overtime, something else is probably askew. And we would like to solve that with you directly.

Lunch

During the workday there is of course time for coffee, tea or whatever you feel like. You will find all refreshments in one of the kitchens. Groceries are ordered weekly in both offices so you can also have breakfast and lunch at the office for free. Bringing your own sandwiches is no longer necessary.

Do you have the skills to make something tasty for your colleagues? Anything is possible, this is even encouraged! To keep things healthy, our vitality heroes are constantly working on offering healthy alternatives, which are also super tasty. Enjoy!

Pension

We have made arrangements for your pension. When you join us, you will be enrolled in Scildon's pension fund. 12Build covers 45% of the pension premium, while you contribute the remaining 55% through your monthly salary.

Each year, 12Build organises an information session with a pension advisor to keep you informed about all the latest developments and options in the pension sector.



Corporate clothing

Everyone can wear what they like; flip-flops and shorts, hoodies and Dr. Martens. There is only 1 rule: if you have an appointment with someone who is not a colleague, you dress business casual. In the onboarding box you'll also find a nice surprise.

Sick call

If you are sick, please report this to your team lead by phone before 8:00 a.m. and make sure your team members and HR are notified by Slack or email. Please also notify them when you are feeling well again.

High praise for our leave policy

Vacation days

As much fun as working at 12Build is, everyone needs a vacation now and then. A break with the family or a city trip with a friend. Or finally make that attic habitable. Do you work full-time? Then you are entitled to 30 vacation days per year. The number of vacation days you accrue depends on your contract hours and the length of your contract.

To encourage our colleagues to actually take leave anyway, our guideline is to carry a maximum of 5 days of leave over to the following year. So we don't take large pots of leave. Needless to say, you are off on national holidays. And although Good Friday is not an official holiday, at 12Build you do have the day off. How good is that?

The same goes for St. Nicholas. Does December 5 fall on a workday? Then we stop at 3 pm.

Special leave

We understand that there are moments in life that require extra time and attention outside of regular vacations. That's why we offer special leave for important events. The page to the right lists the different types of special leave.

Emergency leave

Your water pipe has burst or you have to unexpectedly pick up your child from daycare. Don't panic, you can take emergency leave for this. Emergency leave is intended for unforeseen situations where you must act immediately. Depending on the situation, we will grant you emergency leave within reason.

Flash leave

When it's suddenly pool weather, you suddenly realize in the evening that you want to go to your favorite sports club's championship tribute, or the cans of BaCo at the canteen night were just half price and you notice the consequences the next morning. Then it's time to take flash leave. Of course, before you take flash leave, take a critical look through your schedule, consult with your colleagues to see if they agree, transfer your work properly, and make sure your colleagues know you're not there.

Special leave and associated leave days

Funeral/death of parent, spouse, registered partner, child or foster child	Day of death to day of funeral
For medical visits to a specialist (e.g. doctor)	Annual maximum of 8 hours

Is there a long-term trajectory or chronic complaints? Then we will make arrangements with you about that.

Blood donation is something we hold dear (hehe). Therefore, 50% of this time does not have to be taken as leave. The maximum contribution from 12Build is 8 hours per year.



Care leave

Let's hope you'll never need it, but it's possible you need to provide care to an ill brother, sister, (grand)parent, (grand)child, roommate or acquaintance. In situations like this, you get the first 6 days of fully paid care leave from 12Build (for full-time employees. For part-timers, the maximum contribution is lower on a prorated basis).

Should the care last longer, you can also take long-term care leave. This is unpaid leave. The maximum number of hours of long-term care leave is 6 times your weekly contract hours.

Pregnancy and maternity leave

You are expecting a baby, congratulations! Now it's up to you to slowly let go of work (you can do it!) and enjoy your pregnancy.

You are entitled to 16 weeks of paid leave. The first day of your leave is 6 up to 4 weeks at the latest before your due date. For example, do you go on leave 5 weeks in advance? Then your maternity leave will be one week longer after your due date. You always have at least 10 weeks of maternity leave after birth. Is the baby born after the due date? This does not reduce your maternity leave. You apply for maternity leave with HR. After consulting with HR, you fill in the leave under 'verlof voor kinderen'.

Partner leave for childbirth

A new family member, congratulations! We understand you want to spend some time with your partner and the newest family member first.

Is the baby born on a work day? Then you can request 1 day of calamity leave in Loket. This is fully paid. In addition, you are entitled to 1 time your weekly working hours of partner leave. This leave is also fully paid and you can request it in Loket under "verlof voor kinderen". Because of new government regulations, you can also request an additional 5 weeks (5 x working hours per week) of leave. This is called extended partner leave.

You do not have to take this leave consecutively to birth leave, but you do take it according to a fixed schedule as much as possible. You can use this extended partner leave up to 6 months after the birth date. The hours of extended partner leave are paid at 70% of your salary.

Do you want to take extra extended leave after the birth of your child? Then you can make use of (paid) parental leave.

Parental leave

As a parent, you have until your child is 8 years old to take parental leave. This leave is a maximum of 26 times the number of hours in your work week. Part of this parental leave is paid, namely the first 9 weeks. The main points at a glance:

Key points:

- Paid parental leave lasts a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 9 work weeks. You can only take this for a
 whole week.
- The leave must be taken on a fixed schedule as much as possible.
- You must take the leave within 1 year after the birth of your child. Or within 1 year of joining the family, if your child is adopted or fostered and your child is younger than 8 years old.
- Paid parental leave is paid at 70% of your salary.

Travel allowance

The untaxed travel allowance for commuting is €0.23 per kilometre. You can claim this allowance if you live at least 10 kilometres from work (Google Maps - shortest route). Together we determine how many days per week on average you travel to the office, and you will receive a fixed monthly travel allowance for those days.

Business travel is reimbursed at €0.31 per kilometre. This also applies when you drive from the Nijverdal office to the Zwolle office, or vice versa.

Work from home allowance

At the office, you have the luxury of a nice workplace, free Internet and lunch at no cost. When you work from home, you pay these costs yourself. We have therefore decided to compensate you financially for working from home in the form of a home office allowance.

This compensation amounts to €75 net when you work entirely from home. Together, we determine the average number of days you work from home, so you receive a fixed monthly compensation.



ISO and information security

Patrick Aarbodem, Chief Growth Officer: "Information security is an important topic within 12Build. Not only for our employees but also for our customers. We have established a team that ensures that the ISO 27001 certification (information security) is maintained. But we expect all our employees to actively engage in information security. Everyone reads the information security policy in Confluence.

We report security incidents to the Security Officer. The Security Officer is responsible for monitoring and improving the security of our information systems. We attend awareness sessions by the Compliance Officer and the Security Officer a few times a year. The Compliance Officer ensures that we comply with all relevant information security laws and regulations. When we have questions, we consult with the Security Officer or the Compliance Officer. In this way, together we ensure that our information remains secure."
